## Differences between Stand-Alone Version and Network Version

In terms of copies number of licenses along with different way of managing licenses, we provide two versions of the program --- Stand-Alone Version & Network Version.

### Definition

#### Stand-Alone Version:

Each license is bound to a single user and computer.

Stand-alone licenses are ideal for small offices and dedicated production users, because they do not require network connectivity to run and often cost less than network licenses for the same product

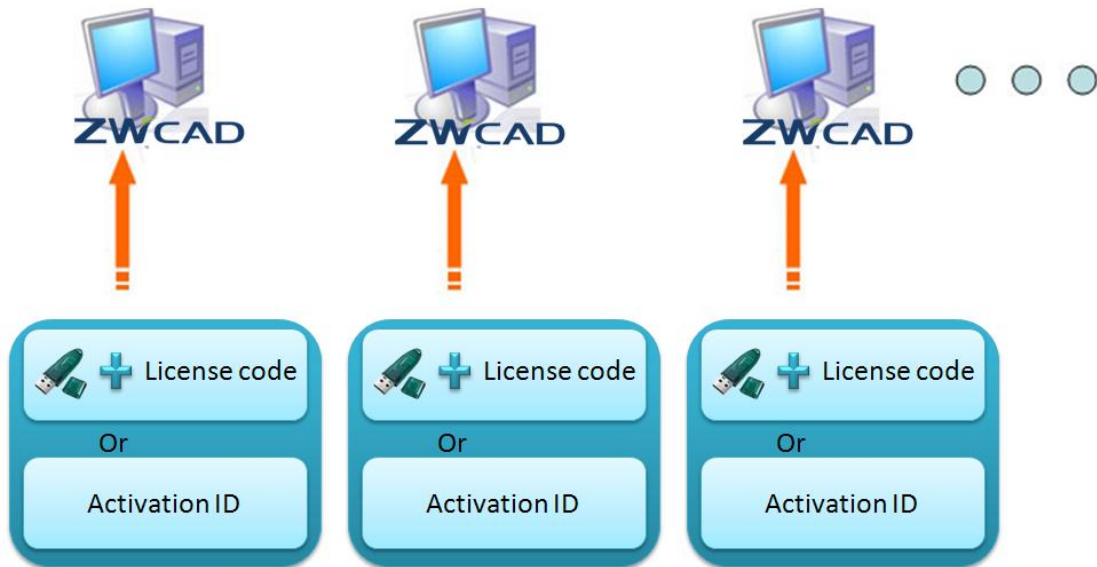
#### Network Version:

Multiple copies for a license, and a license manager should be installed on the server which meant to manage the licenses. Workstations can get floating licenses (or borrow licenses) from the authorized server.
