Differences between Stand-Alone Version and Network Version

In terms of license management & license number, we provide two versions of the program --- Stand-Alone Version & Network Version.

Definition

Stand-Alone Version:

Each license is bound to a single user and computer.

Stand-alone licenses are ideal for small offices and dedicated production users, because they do not require network connection to run.

Network Version:

Multiple copies for a license, and a license manager should be installed on the server which is meant to manage the licenses. Workstations can get floating licenses (or borrow licenses) from the authorized server.
